## INAUGURAL ANNUAL CONFERENCE OF THE ECOWAS REGIONAL COMPETITION AUTHORITY (ERCA) Banjul, The Gambia, 15-17 September 2026

### INFORMATION NOTE

*The ECOWAS Regional Competition Authority (ERCA) warmly welcomes you to its Inaugural Annual Conference, convened under the theme "Competition Policy and Market Integration in ECOWAS: Issues, Challenges and Opportunities".*

Below is some useful information regarding the administrative arrangements for this Conference.

#### **I. Venue and dates**

The Conference will be held from 15 to 17 September 2026 at the Sir Dawda Kairaba Jawara International Conference Centre (SDKJ-ICC), Bijilo, The Gambia.



## **II. Conference working hours and languages**

The conference will be held from 09:00 to 17.30 each day.

Conference sessions will be conducted in English, French, and Portuguese with simultaneous interpretation provided.

## **III. Secretariat and Registration**

Participant registration will take place from 08:00 a.m. to 09:00 am on 15 September 2026 at the SDKJ-ICC. Participants are strongly encouraged to register online through the following link <https://erca-arcc.org/final-registration-form-for-badge-for-participants-erca-inaugural-annual-conference/>

Onsite registration will also be available at the Conference venue.

## **IV. Hotel Information**

Participants are advised to make their own hotel reservations. A list of recommended hotels is attached to this bulletin. Participants are also encouraged to confirm their hotel reservations early (by sending reservation bookings and itineraries to [annualconf@erca-arcc.org](mailto:annualconf@erca-arcc.org)) to avoid last-minute inconveniences. Special rates for the Conference have been negotiated with the recommended Hotels.

## **V. Travel**

Participants are advised to arrive in Banjul on 14 September and, where possible, to return to their respective countries on 18 September 2026.

Arrangements have been made to welcome and assist you upon arrival at the airport.

For participants who require an entry visa for The Gambia, arrangements are being made with the relevant authorities to facilitate, where possible, the issuance of visas upon arrival.

The Gambia charges an airport mandatory security levy of USD 20 for both arriving and departing passengers. Holders of a diplomatic passport are exempted.

Participants are advised to travel with their vaccination certificates, as they may be requested by health authorities at the airport.

## **VI. Airport Transfers and Local Transportation**

Transport shall be provided for all delegates from Banjul International Airport to the recommended hotels, and between the hotels and the Conference venue (SDKJ-ICC).

The conference organizer will provide support on airport formalities, reception, accreditation, and escort of official delegations.

## **VII. Time and Weather**

The time in The Gambia corresponds to Coordinated Universal Time (UTC).

In September, the weather is generally warm, with rainfall and periods of sunshine, as September falls within the rainy season.

## **VIII. Banks and Currency**

The official currency is the Gambian Dalasi (GMD). The exchange rate is approximately USD 1 = GMD 73. Commercial banks handle international currencies and accept major international payment cards. Banking hours are generally Monday to Friday, 08:00 – 16:00.

Licensed foreign-exchange bureaus are widely available in Banjul, Serekunda, and along the coastal strip. Major hotels also offer currency exchange services.

## **IX. Electrical sockets and voltage**

**Type G** three-pin plugs are commonly used in The Gambia. If your device has a different type of plug, you will need a travel adaptor to use it with the local sockets.

The voltage in Gambia is **220–240 V**, 50 Hz. You are therefore advised to check that your electrical equipment is compatible with this voltage before use.

Please note that travel adaptors only change the shape of the plug to fit the local sockets; they do not change the voltage or frequency of the electricity supply.

## **X. Telephones**

Direct international telephone connections are available. When calling The Gambia, dial +220 followed by the required number.

Internet access is widely available in hotels and at the Conference venue.

The mobile network operators in The Gambia are Africell, QCell, Comium and Gamcel, with SIM cards available at the Banjul International Airport and at Customer Service Centers of the respective Mobile operators.
